## Dear Senators:

As a representative of Illinois' 1.4 million small businesses, we urge you to support SB 1784, known as Clean Slate, legislation that automates the process of sealing criminal records to help our fellow Illinoisans get back to work and strengthen our communities.

Illinois is a great place to live and work, but many Illinoisans face barriers to economic participation. We need to ensure that everyone who is ready to work can find employment so that our economy can continue growing. More than 3 million Illinoisans have some form of a criminal record, many from offenses long in the past.
