Opinion Poll: Small businesses support Section 199A reform and bottom-up tax benefits

Methodology

This survey, conducted by Small Business Majority from April 18-22, 2025, was an online panel of 504 small business owners nationwide. The sample is politically mixed: 41% of respondents are/lean Republican, 36% are/lean Democrat and 21% are independents. The margin of error is +- 4% at a 95% confidence level.

The Section 199A Qualified Business Income (QBI) Deduction was enacted through the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act. It allows the deduction of up to 20% of eligible business income for federal taxes. This deduction applies to “pass-through” businesses, where the owners’ business income is recognized on their personal returns. Various types of businesses can claim the deduction, including sole proprietorships, limited liability corporations, partnerships, S-corporations, estates, trusts and some rental businesses.
